The President's Message to Parents, Students and Other Stakeholders

AY 2020-2021

The Davao Medical School Foundation, Inc. wishes to inform everyone that with the on-going Covid-19 pandemic, and the decision of the government to suspend face-to-face instruction effective March 2020, the College of Medicine, and other health science programs, decided to shift to flexible learning for the remaining weeks of the second semester, AY 2019-20.

With this sudden shift to flexible learning, the administration decided to

1. Provide discounts on certain student fees covering the period of the lockdown (March 14, 2020 and onwards);
2. Discounted fees will be credited to students' fees for the incoming academic year 2020-21;
3. School fees for the incoming AY 2020-21 will also be adjusted In consideration of the shift to blended learning;
4. Due to physical distancing and other safety measures, the school will not hold a face-to-face graduation ceremony for AY 2019-2020

Conscious of its vision and mission, and its role in the current health crises, DMSFI is now ready to welcome students to its Doctor of Medicine, Doctor of Dentistry, BS in Nursing, BS / Diploma in Midwifery, and Biology programs for the incoming academic year 2020-2021. It will retain its outcomes-based curriculum (OBE), but due to the safety guidelines issued by the IATF-EID, the delivery of instruction and assessment will be temporarily modified to on-line, off-line and limited rotational face-to-face instruction and assessment (blended learning).

As a PAASCU accredited medical school, with the most modern instructional infrastructure, and competent, dedicated and committed faculty, the College of Medicine and other health science programs shall continue to provide quality instruction. Moreover, DMSF is equipped with instructional resources and facilities that can provide

1. On-line, off-line and rotational face-to-face instruction and assessment (blended learning);
2. Simulated patients in lieu of the prohibition on deployment of students to hospitals, clinics and the community; these include standardized patients, virtual patients, high-fidelity mannequins and paper cases;
3. Student assessment of clinical skills using automated scoring in our simulated hospital and OPD wards (24 OSCE stations);
4. Digitized histo-pathologic slides using slide scanners;
5. Digitized structures of the different parts of human body using plastinated cadavers, anatomage, and radiologic/ultrasound/CT-scan imaging;
6. E-library where e-books and e-journals can be accessed;
7. Learning management system (LMS) where class list, class schedule, lectures and laboratory exercises, examinations and automated grade computations are uploaded, and accessed;
8. On-line connectivity such as teleconsultation, online application of new students, and online enrollment;
9. Support system by our numerous highly-trained IT staff.

- A. For student-applicants to our **Doctor of Medicine** program, you can visit our website at www.dmsf.edu.ph to download the application form and submit the preliminary requirements:
1. Filled-up application form
 2. College diploma or Certificate of graduation from previous college/university;
 3. True copy of transcript of records
 4. NMAT result (minimum score of 40 percentile)
 5. 2 IDs - previous school ID and any government ID (preferably passport)
 6. 2 copies of applicant's recent photo, passport size, duly signed by the applicant at the lower border of the picture
 7. Short essay (not more than 100 words) on why I want to be a doctor
 8. Proof of payment of application fee (P500.00)

Applicants who will qualify in the screening will be interviewed thru phone call or online call using viber or other social apps. Once accepted, a LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE will be issued thru email. The applicant can now proceed with on-line enrollment with the Office of the Registrar (email: registrar@email.dmsf.edu.ph).

7. Short essay (not more than 100 words) on why I choose Dentistry
8. Proof of payment of application fee of P2,500.00

2. Certified true copy of transcript of records of previous school;
3. Certified true copy of Certificate of Good Moral Character from previous school;
4. Certificate of Honorable Dismissal;
5. Certified true copy of Certificate of Eligibility for Dentistry (CED) issued by previous school;
6. Original copy of Birth certificate from Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) or NSO;
7. Passport size ID picture (colored, with red or blue background);
8. Short essay (not more than 100 words) on why I choose Dentistry

Applicants who will qualify in the screening will be issued a NOTICE OF ACCEPTANCE and PRE-REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE thru email. Other requirements such as entrance exam, interview and medical examination will be scheduled later. The applicant can now proceed with on-line enrollment with the Office of the Registrar (email: registrar@email.dmsf.edu.ph).

Furthermore, the College of Dentistry wishes to disclose the following adaptations in our T/L strategies:

1. With its compliance to Outcome-Based Learning, and Flexible Learning as prescribed by the CHED to replace face-to-face schooling, it has integrated the lecture and laboratory classes to optimize time and immediate learning;
2. Consistent with new learning methods, the College will implement strategies that encourage self-directed learning and open-promotion (advancement based on the initiative of the learner and not in a fixed semester standard);
3. More importantly, it shall deliver approaches to encourage learning and mental health support, while observing ethical considerations;
4. Improve access to e-learning and more critical-thinking level of cognitive development;
5. As for the practical phase of learning in Clinical Dentistry, the Dental Infirmary, where "live patients" are completely discouraged, our facility is complete with equipment for typodont exercises that stimulate the natural dentition, along with Objective Structured Clinical Examination (OSCE) method of assessment; all focused in preparation for the tough Dental Licensure Examinations.

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In the equally urgent matter of finances, the College has:

1. Re-assessed its fees that adapt to the new standards, thus expect discounted tuition fees;
 2. Arranged favourable payment schemes.
